We invited six representatives from different aspects of town life to tell us about areas of their work where we could support them in prayer. Here is an indication of the prayer points they shared:
Robert Harrison, Chief Operating Officer for the Harrogate and District NHS Trust spoke about Health. Cllr Don Mackenzie from North Yorkshire County Council spoke about Local Politics. Jean Macquarrie, Editor of the Harrogate Advertiser, spoke about the Media. Steve Scarre, President of Harrogate and District Chamber of Commerce, spoke about Business; Lisa Winwood, the very recently appointed Chief Constable for North Yorkshire spoke about the Police, and Julia Collins, Headteacher at St Peter's Primary School, spoke about Education.
This was an excellent, and very well supported, event. It was a great opportunity to gain an insight into the challenges faced by some key individuals in our community, and, as Christians with a common purpose, to pray for them.
