Priest on Placement – Judith Clark

Having served three years of her curacy at Leeds Minster, The Revd Judith Clark will be joining us for a full-time placement during September, October and November this year. Judith has gained a wide range of experience in Leeds. Not only, of course, dealing with Covid but also having her Training Incumbent move to become Bishop of Stockport. This has meant that, among other unusual responsibilities for a Curate, Judith found herself appearing in the BBC 1 Easter Service.



Prior to ordination Judith worked as a Pastoral Assistant for the Joint Benefice of St Michael and All Angels, Beckwithshaw and St. Robert's, Pannal. From there she went to train at Ripon College, Cuddesdon – overlapping with our own Associate Vicar, Chris Clayton. Alongside ordination training and curacy Judith has also been doing doctoral research through Oriel College, Oxford. Her thesis focuses on one of the worship texts found amongst the Dead Sea Scrolls.

Judith says: "I love travelling and enjoy the thrill of discovering new places as much as uncovering the 'new' when re-visiting old favourites. Time spent with family and friends, going to the theatre, eating out, reading, listening to music and kickboxing are also pastimes which I enjoy. I am excited and very much look forward to joining you at St Peter's for a placement and to meeting you all soon!"
