# The Bereavement Journey – a course starting in September

The Bereavement Journey is for anyone who has been bereaved at any time but would value time and safe space to process their grief. It is a series of films and discussion groups that gently guide participants through the common aspects of grief



and bereavement, enabling them to process the implications for themselves and think about the next steps.

We will be running the course here at St Peter's on Monday evenings from  $4^{th}$  September –  $16^{th}$  October (6:30 – 9:00 pm) in the Brostoff Hall. There will also be a daytime course on Wednesday afternoons from  $13^{th}$  September –  $25^{th}$  October (12:30 – 3:00 pm) at St Mark's Church.

- Attachment, separation and loss
- The pain and responses of grief
- Anger and guilt
- Coping with others' reactions
- Delayed and suppressed grief
- Adjusting to change
- Moving forward healthily






