What happens at the Healing Service?

A quiet, and easily overlooked, feature of St Peter's weekly worship is the Healing Service which takes place at 12 noon on Tuesdays. Perhaps you've seen this on the calendar and wondered what's involved?

The service takes place on the red dais around the nave altar. That immediately tells you that it is a small, intimate service attended by a small number of people – perhaps eight in total. We use two different forms of liturgy, one with and one

without Holy Communion.

The atmosphere of this service is still and reflective. Some people come every week; others are passers-by who come in off the street. It is a time when it's possible to what mention you'd like prayer for, or not – whichever It's also an you prefer. opportunity to bring others to God in prayer.

As part of the service the leader places his or her hand

on each person's shoulder and prays:

In the name of God, and trusting in his might alone, receive Christ's healing touch to make you whole.

May Christ give you wholeness of body, mind and spirit, deliver you from every evil, and fill you with his peace. Amen

If you need a place where you can be quiet with others before God, or if you have something in particular for which you'd appreciate prayer, then do feel welcome to join us at the Healing Service.

St Peter's Ladies who Lunch




