Celebrating the 10th year of *Thy Kingdom Come*



Thy Kingdom Come (TKC) is a prayer movement that invites Christians around the world to pray from Ascension Day to the Day of Pentecost – this year that's Thursday 29th May until Sunday 8th June.

What started in 2016 as an invitation from the Archbishops of Canterbury and York to the Church of England, has grown into an international and ecumenical movement, which unites more than a million Christians in prayer, in nearly 90% of countries worldwide, across 85 different denominations and traditions.

During the eleven days everyone is encouraged to pray that God's Spirit might work in the lives of five specific people who have not yet responded to God's call. To help you do this there are all sorts of free resources available to download from www.thykingdomcome.global - including a new Novena by Archbishop Stephen Cottrell, a new prayer journal based on the Lord's Prayer and digital detox guides. *Daily Prayer for Thy Kingdom Come* is available on Apple and Android devices and includes audio for each daily service. For the first time ever, there's a Youth Prayer Journal and accompanying session guides. For children and families, ***The Cheeky Pandas*** are also back this year (*see inside for details*). with a brand new series exploring different styles of prayer, all based on the Lord's Prayer.

Whether you have joined in '*Thy Kingdom Come*' before or not, you are invited to take part and join in this year.




Come to *The Market Day Café* next Thursday

Thy Kingdom Come for Children

In 2021 **Cheeky Pandas**, with the support of the Archbishop of Canterbury, became the primary family resource for his global prayer initiative, *Thy Kingdom Come*.

Cheeky Pandas was the idea of Pete James, a writer of children's worship songs and music videos, and seeks to make the Good News accessible to all,

equipping churches and families with free resources, helping children and youth to discover Jesus. This resource is one of a kind: a British-made Christian cartoon series, freely available, Bible-based, fun, friendly, music-based, and with stacks of extra resources.

The resources are targeted at children in Key Stage 1, aged 5 – 8 years. They can be used by parents, grandparents, children's groups, Sunday groups, after-school activities, and schools. There are three series of animated **Cheeky Panda** episodes, and every episode comes with a BSL version, a music videos, free downloadable activity packs, assembly plans and widget packs for neurodivergent children.

New episodes of the **Cheeky Pandas** have been created for *Thy Kingdom Come 2025*. So come on, join the Cheeky Pandas and all their amazing friends in a world of fun with this wonderful free resource.
