Looking back at Prayer Spaces in Schools


Thanks to all of you who prayed for the *Prayer Spaces in Schools* Week at St Peter's CE School. The team lugged interesting objects, gazebos, tents, twinkly lights, tech gear and light tubes up many stone steps to transform a multi-purpose room into a haven full of calming hidey-holes for children aged 9 - 11 to think, pray and 'be'.



Children entered the room in small groups and split up to try whichever activities took their fancy for about half an hour. Watching children, who are often glued to their phones or racing from one event to another, have time to think their thoughts and respond to the prayer prompts was captivating. One of

our team reported feeling tearful as she watched one child, completely relaxed and unself-conscious in front of her peers, kneeling with her hands together to pray.

One of the most popular stations was the Forgiveness Stones, where children could drop the burden of a stone of unforgiveness into a bucket as they let grudges go. It was equally moving to see some stones lined up beside the bucket, for those who were not ready or able to take that step - it was a place of honesty! In these uncertain days, it was powerful to see children (and teachers)



wrap themselves in the hand-crocheted prayer blanket to represent receiving God's comfort. One member of staff said, 'It's deep. I don't normally have time to think.'

West Wall repairs update

We are pleased to announce that on Monday 24th March the scaffolding will be coming down to reveal a repaired and painted West Wall. The loose masonry was removed in September 2024, and the wall left to dry for six months. In the last two weeks, our masonry contractor has returned to apply lime mortar and repaint the entire West Wall in breathable paint. We made a large saving on the cost of scaffolding by negotiating an excellent monthly hire rate to leave it in situ instead of paying for it to be dismantled and re-erected to complete the work. We would like to thank Graham Bailey Masonry contractor and Premier Scaffolding for their excellent work throughout this project, and thanks to you too for your patience while the work was carried out.

Good Friday Prayer Walk: a walk of reflection, meditation and worship






Our mini-supermarket is on Thursdays from 4:30 – 4:50 pm, when anyone can come to stock up, no questions asked.
