



St Peter's Fuel Poverty Grants – the deadline is TODAY!





Albania: a secret land revealed

After World War II Albania became a Communist state, ruled by dictator Enver Hoxha (*right*) until his death in 1985. Learn to sing with Harrogate Harmony Men's Chorus





St Wilfrid's Procession returns to the streets of Ripon

After being postponed for two years, Ripon's traditional St Wilfrid's procession will be back this summer from 1:45 – 4:30 pm on Saturday 30th July. Held in honour of the city's patron saint, St Wilfrid, the procession around Ripon dates back to 1108 when King Henry I granted a charter to



the City to hold an annual fair each year around this time.

Many local organisations enter floats and there are usually marching bands and Morris dancers, all led by St Wilfrid on his horse. Ripon Cathedral will be taking part, trundling their enormous Wilfra Tart on wheels through the streets and handing out Wilfra tarts to the crowd.
