
St Peter's Afternoon Fellowship

To celebrates its 1350th year, Syrian artist Sara Shamma (*right*), Leeds artist Jack Chesterman, sound artist Paul Baily, from York, and local poet laureate, Olivia Mulligan, were all commissioned to produce new work for Ripon Cathedral to tell afresh the life and legacy of its founding father, Wilfrid, through art. Sara's portraits depict three influential figure from their Anglo-



Saxon past – St Wilfrid, Queen Eanfled and Archbishop Theodore of Tarsus. The *From Rome to Ripon* exhibition is free and runs until 1st November.
