You are invited to 'Being With'!



From 26th January to 2nd April, our Curate, Karin Shaw; Prayer Ministry Leader, Pauline Harrison; and Lay Readers, Stuart and Catharine Davies; are putting on the *Being With* course – ten weeks of gatherings online. We are offering a Sunday and a weekday (Wednesday) group, both meeting from 7:15 – 8:45 pm.

We will spend time with one another, building relationships in a relaxed but structured way to explore faith (especially those who are new to it or have questions). It will be as comfortable as chatting in the pub, but it is also structured – so the time flies, no one voice dominates and we are kept 'on-topic'! And meeting online means you can choose your favourite drink! Because we are all made in the image of God, we expect to also meet with God as we consider one another's stories. These conversations do not need prior knowledge or study – just a simple willingness to share what you do know or feel ...

Each session has a theme. Participants are invited (not compelled!) to share ideas or experiences which help us mull it over. It is a conversation, not something to prepare. A short talk is presented, written by Sam Wells, Vicar of St Martin-in-the-Fields (and a regular speaker on *Thought for the Day* on Radio 4), and then there is more conversation. Our stories are weaved into Sam's talk. It is wonder-ful!


Come for lunch next Sunday



An update from Wellspring Therapy & Training



Like many charities, Wellspring is now facing challenges due to the cost-of-living crisis. Increased demand and reduced income require us to adapt and make changes to ensure our long-term sustainability. To navigate these turbulent times, we've undertaken a comprehensive


