Reflect are holding a 'Light a candle' event at St Peter's

As a member of the Baby Loss Awareness Alliance, *Reflect* has been holding a 'Light a Candle' event during Baby Loss Awareness Week for several years here at St Peter's. This year it will be on Tuesday 10th October in St Mary's Chapel, beginning during the weekly Healing Service and lasting until 2:00 pm.

Over the years it has proved a special moment when families — mothers, fathers, grandparents - come to light a candle in recognition of a loss. *Reflect* volunteers are on hand to guide and to sit awhile with anyone wanting further support, though some mothers simply take the opportunity for a quiet moment with their own thoughts and memories.

Reflect is a free support service in Harrogate, York and Selby for anyone facing a pregnancy choice and for those struggling after experiencing pregnancy loss. The vision is to see anyone in North Yorkshire enabled to make an informed decision about a pregnancy choice, without fear, pressure or judgment, and to support those who have been affected by pregnancy loss through miscarriage, stillbirth or termination of pregnancy, or who have experienced neonatal loss.



As a charity *Reflect* offers a structured support programme, 'Walking with Loss', to help work through emotions and grief. Whether the loss was recent or many years ago, trained volunteers help clients work through their experience.


Come for lunch next Sunday




