


## The Market Day Café is on Thursday

They also issue a plea to everyone to put 'good grace and a commitment to truth and integrity' at the heart of the campaign.

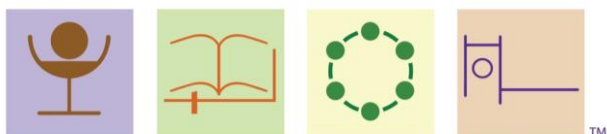
