It was due to lockdown that we realised as a Church that we needed to strengthen our capacity to offer practical and pastoral care, which I believe we have done in many ways since then.

Offering pastoral care has given me the opportunity to get to know so many more of you within our Church community, and it is a privilege for all of our dedicated pastoral team to be able to offer the support and care to people with specific needs. We place a

special priority on those who are housebound or in hospital, providing a valuable link between those in need and those who can provide the support needed.

We each have our own individual skills – and it is because of this that we can appropriately offer the right type of support as and when required. Our home communion provision has grown and includes visiting those who are housebound, in care homes, in hospital or recovering from illness or hospitalisation.


Could you serve on the Parochial Church Council?
